

# Medline Gives Back to the Community

## FIRST IMPRESSIONS

Overhauled two existing garden beds at entry of school.  
 Built two retaining walls, planted 30 additional shrubs and 16 garden mums, weeded, trimmed existing shrubs and added approximately 16 cubic yards of mulch.  
 Created a bright and inviting entrance by painting welcome murals for the fence.

## MURALS

Added color and energy with seven murals, emphasizing health, education and literacy themes.

## BASEBALL FIELD

Converted an unused green space to a completely functional baseball field!

## CONSTRUCTION

Assembled a storage shed that was put to immediate use for donated hoses.  
 Built and filled four planter boxes for the front entrance of the school.  
 Painted the railings, risers and baseboards in two stairwells.  
 Built and stained nine bookshelves.

## PLAYGROUND

Created a brighter, more functional and educational outdoor space.  
 Constructed four picnic benches, creating a welcome gathering space.  
 Designed a welcome mosaic for the front entrance of the school.  
 Used paint to make five playground structures look brand new.

## MAXIMIZING SPACE

Created an outdoor classroom so teachers and students can make the most of this previously unused outdoor area.  
 Dug out, mulched and planted 16 shrubs in a 158 foot garden bed running along the fence line and planted bushes and shrubs on the fence line along the perimeter of the school, spanning 1,535 feet.  
 Created three new garden beds by planting three ornamental crab trees, 25 shrubs and 24 garden mums, building a retaining wall and spreading 13 cubic yards of mulch.

## SOCCER FIELD

Created a soccer field in an underused area of grass.
